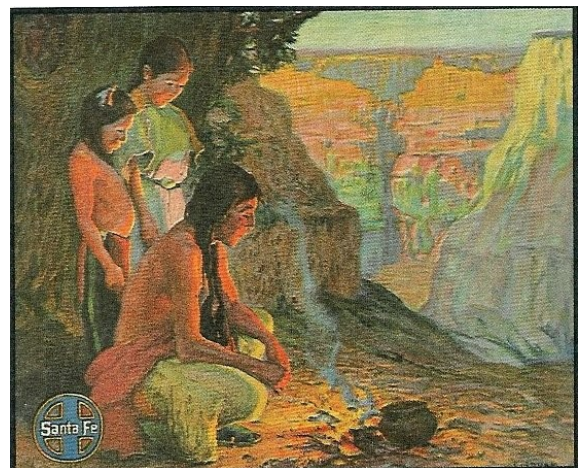
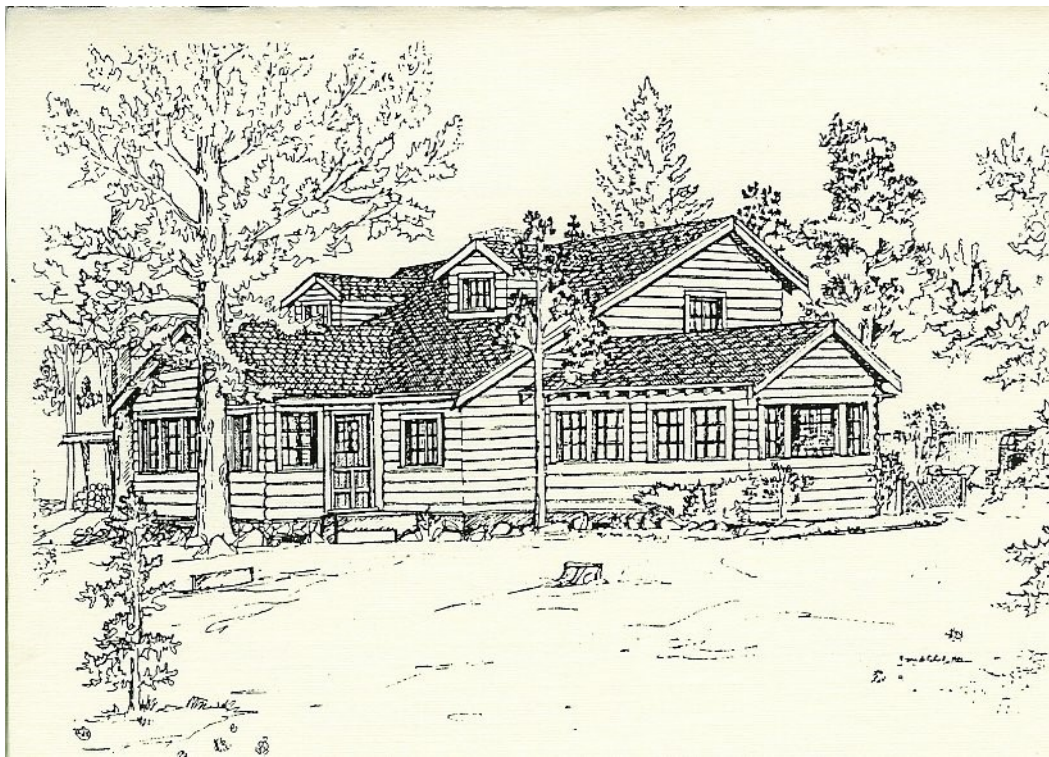


ODE TO WOODLAND PARK
